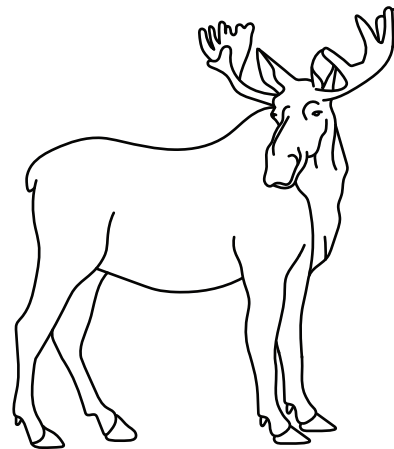
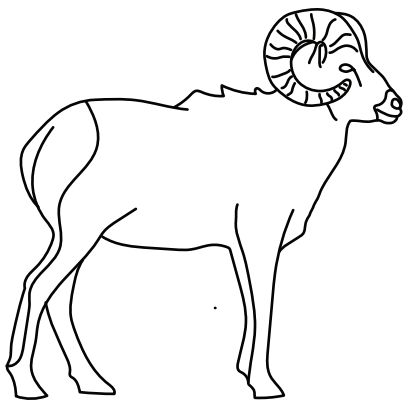
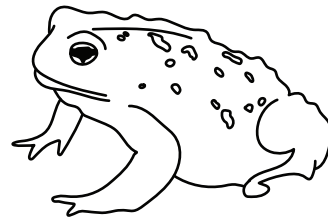
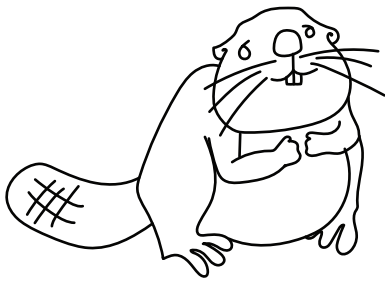
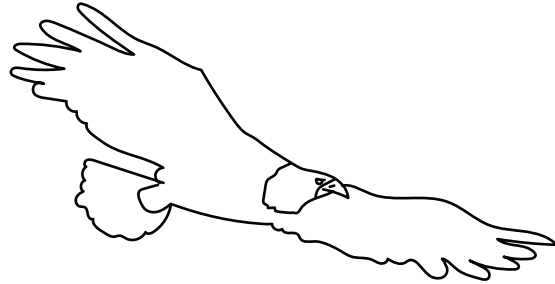
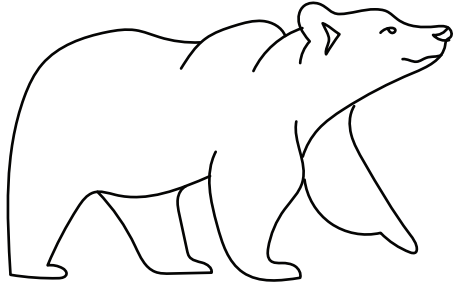
HIGH FIVE! ²

Can you help us identify each species? Draw a line from each species name to its matching picture. Then give them some color!




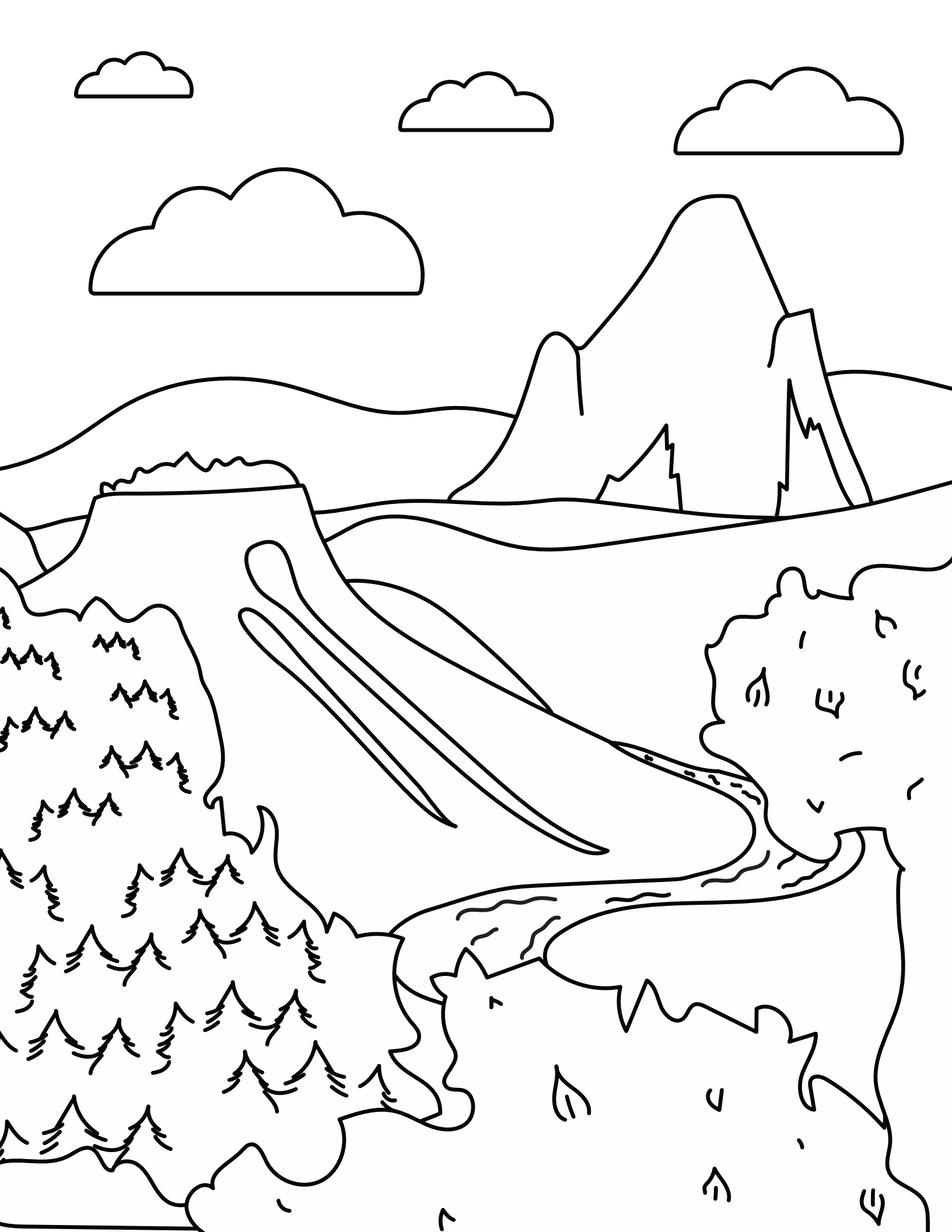

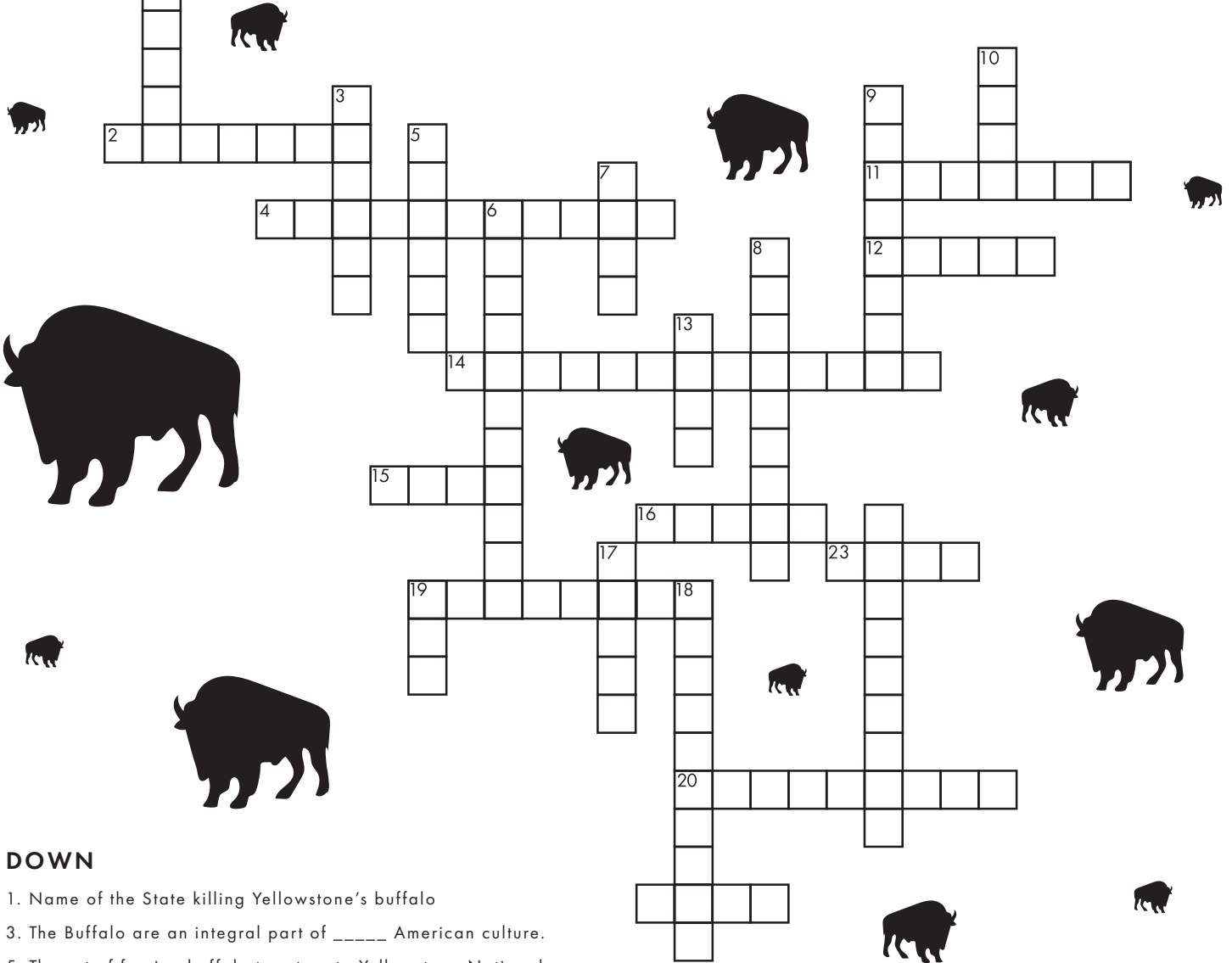
DID YOU KNOW?

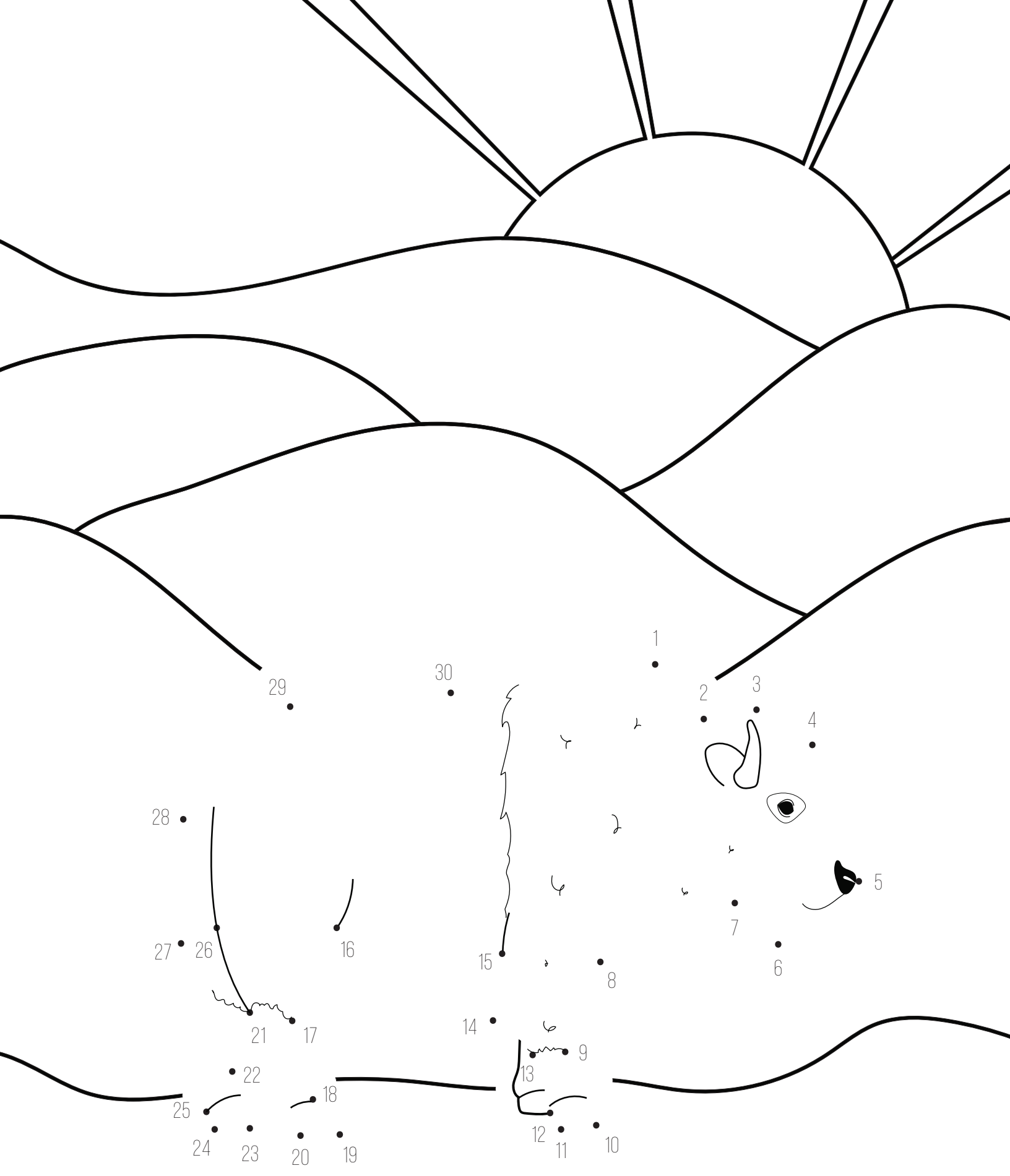

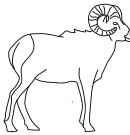

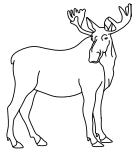
