Buffalo Field Campaign's mission is to stop the harassment and slaughter of Yellowstone's wild buffalo herds; protect the natural habitat of wild, free-roaming buffalo and other native wildlife; and work with all people-especially Indigenous Nations-to honor and protect the sacredness of the wild buffalo.

In the past year, we successfully:

- Completed our twenty-second season in the field monitoring buffalo migration corridors and documenting abuses.
- Hosted, trained, and educated thirty-six volunteers.
- Produced "Wild Buffalo in Boulder" multi-media exhibit at the Boulder Museum for a four and a half-month run.
- Participated in Bozeman International Film Festival screening of the documentary short "Our National Mammal" of which we were the associate producer and provider of archival footage.
- Interacted with hundreds of Yellowstone National Park visitors during our annual summer education and outreach efforts.
